- Proven concept meant moving quickly









- Sleeps one individual and a pet.
- Will be fully furnished (bedding, towels, mini fridge, light dishes, etc.)
- In Spring, communities will be expanded to include community lands caping/gardens and recreation opportunities based on resident input.
- After a village is decommissioned, the units will either move to a different area of need or stored for emergency responses.
